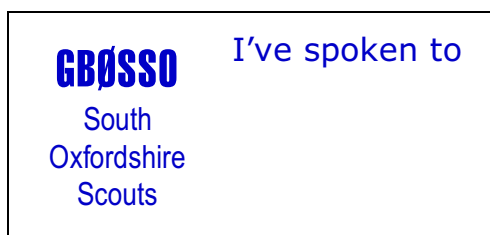
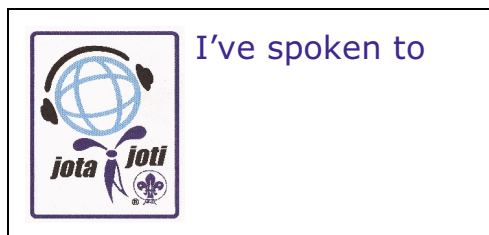


Stickers
